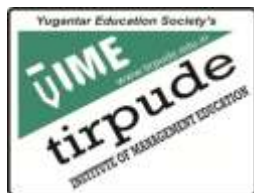

Rules/ Guidelines

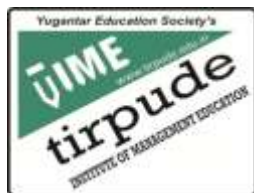
- Only individual participants can register.
